Getting Along with Your Notebook ... on the road



Wheeled luggage or 2-strap backpacks are the best way to transport notebook computers. If you do use a shoulder bag, straps should be well-padded; remember to alternate shoulders frequently.

By car: Please be sure that the computer stays in the case, in a restrained area.

Serious injuries have occurred from 'flying computers' during auto accidents.

By air: checkpoint-friendly cases eliminate the need to remove your computer to place it directly on the X-ray conveyor belt, reducing risk of damage or theft.
