

FY2009 Sensitive Property List Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory

Sensitive property is defined as property that is highly portable, easily converted to personal use and is more susceptible to theft than other equipment. The property listed below is considered **sensitive property** regardless of its acquisition cost. Sensitive property must be barcode tagged and is subject to Laboratory inventory requirements.

Personal Digital Assistant (PDA) Devices/Smart Phones	Palm, Blackberry, iPhone, Electronic Notebook & Tablet
Printers	Digital and Color or Black & White Laser
Portable Hand-Held Radios	Multi-Band Walkie-Talkie
Recorders/Players	Digital, Dictation, Compact Audio Disk (CD), Digital Video Disk (DVD), MP3 Player
Still and Video Cameras	Compact Digital, 35mm Single Lens Reflex (SLR), Digital SLR, Digital Video
Video Projector	Digital
Powered Headsets	Noise-cancelling Headset
