Course Purpose: This course is designed for Facilities and other infrastructure support personnel to enable them to drill into asbestos containing sheetrock in buildings 70 and 70A where asbestos is not only found in the taping compound, but also in the sheetrock itself. Additionally, this training can be applied to all buildings onsite where drilling into asbestos containing taping compound is necessary. This course is a hands on training class that demonstrates the various methods that can be used to safely drill into sheetrock and taping compound that contains asbestos. EHS 339, Asbestos Awareness classroom training is needed prior to taking and receiving credit for EHS 334.

Course Objectives: Hands on training on the various methods used to drill into sheetrock and taping compound (i.e., shaving cream, water, HEPA vac, and wet sponge methods).

Course Instructional Materials: Instructor will be using small section of sheetrock, shaving cream, spray bottle of water, wet sponge, and a cordless drill
